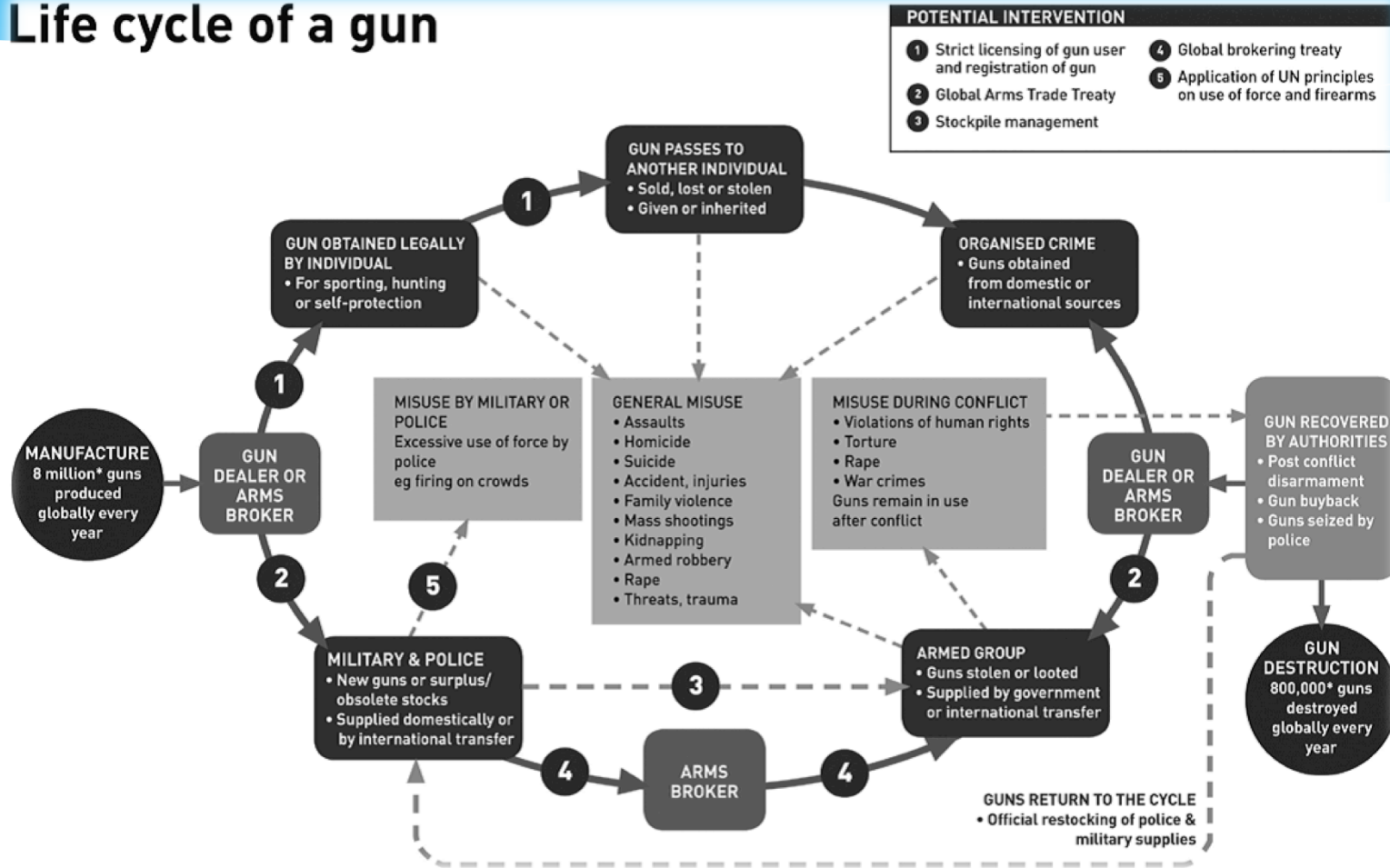

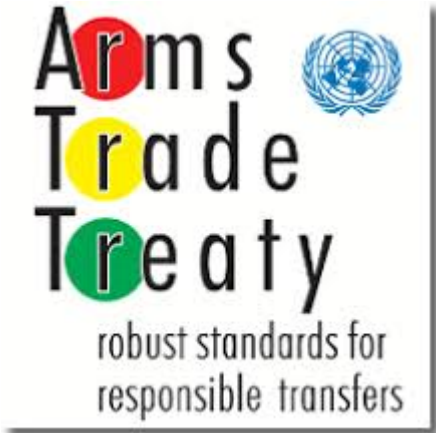
Life cycle of a gun
